

Sport's Grant 2015 - 2016

Monks Coppenhall Academy has received our annual sum of money from the Government to support the development of Physical Education and sport in the school. Below are the areas which we are focusing on and the attached data sheet shows the cost of each area.

- Throughout the year, we have employed specialist coaches to work with children in Key Stage 2 to develop their skills in athletics. This has prepared children for the annual Sports hall competition against other schools and the Town Sports due to take place in June.
- The school has offered a variety of sports clubs during and after school throughout the year. These have been run by specialist coaches. These clubs have been based on feedback from the children about what sports they would like to take part in, in order to increase participation. Here are some of the sports offered: football, tag rugby, mini - athletics ,archery, stay active, multi - sports, boxercise and rounders.
- The purchase of a new long jump pit cover.
- Two further members of staff will complete the module one swimming teacher's course and we are currently using this expertise to support existing staff in the delivery of swimming lessons.
- We have concentrated on years 4, 5 and 6 this year for swimming so far. We will be purchasing swimming certificates for those children who have attained their 25m award.
- We have continued to use specialist coaches and teachers to provide CPD to staff with a focus on our Newly Qualified

Teachers. This has helped to develop staff confidence in the planning and delivery of P.E.

- We have used a specialist cheerleading coach from the Matrix to deliver a lunch time club. The children choreographed a routine which they performed at the annual competition.
- A specialist P.E. teacher continued to deliver a variety of after school clubs for KS2. These are linked with level 2 competitions throughout the year. These include football, netball, tag rugby, athletics and kwik cricket.

Additional P.E. projects.

- Working with staff to ensure that children participate in at least 3 inter-school competitions or tournaments throughout the year, linked to the PE curriculum.
- Involving the school council in finding out what children at Monks Coppenhall would like to be offered in P.E. lessons and through after school activities.
- Development of Play leader scheme to involve year 5 children in a training programme during PE lessons.
- To continue to work on specific targets in order to gain the School Games Kite mark award for the second year running.
