

Sports Grant 2016 - 2017

In the academic year 2016-17, Monks Coppenhall Academy received £9,710 from the Government to support the development of Physical Education and sport in the school. Below are the areas which we focused on and the attached data sheet shows the cost of each area.

- Throughout the year, we have employed a specialist coach to work with children across the Academy to develop their skills in all aspects of PE. We have used £2,660 of the Sports Grant to help fund this provision.
- The Academy has offered a variety of sports clubs during and after school throughout the year. These have been run by staff and specialist coaches. These clubs have been based on feedback from the children about what sports they would like to take part in, in order to increase participation. Here are some of the sports offered: football, tag rugby, athletics, archery, stay active, multi-sports, boxercise, cross country, volley ball and rounders. Children also attended inter-schools sports competitions for Cross Country, Volley Ball and Athletics. The total cost for the clubs and transport to competitions was £1,216
- A further member of staff completed the module one swimming teacher's course at a cost of £99. We are currently using this expertise to support existing staff in the delivery of swimming lessons.
- We have concentrated on years 4, 5 this year for swimming. We will be purchasing swimming certificates for those children who have attained their 25m award. In addition, Year 6 children attended Top Up swimming lessons over a two week period to ensure that they could swim the required distance. The total cost of the Top Up swimming was £602 which was paid from the Sports Grant
- We have continued to use specialist coaches and teachers to provide CPD to staff with a focus on our Newly Qualified Teachers. This has helped to develop staff confidence in the planning and delivery of P.E. The total costs for this was £2900 including supply cover for the PE Coordinator
- We have used £150 from the Sport Grant to employ a specialist cheerleading coach from the Matrix to deliver a lunch time club. The children choreographed a routine which they performed at the annual competition.
- A range of equipment was purchased throughout the year at a cost of £872. This will give children the opportunity to participate in a wide range of sports.
- We organised a Sports Week run by Premier Sports at a cost of £480. During Sports week, all children participated in a sporting activity. These sessions were delivered by an outside agency and included: archery, karate, fencing and

Lacrosse in KS2. In KS1 children participated in a fun football session called Jolly Olly Soccer Island.

- Year 3 and 5 pupils attended a workshop to improve their knowledge and understanding of a Healthy Lunchbox. This was delivered by Angela Hitchen and cost £200
- We have used £500 of Sports Grant to renew our annual membership of the Crewe Schools Sports Partnership.
- In addition to the above we have also purchased stickers for Sports Day at a cost of £31.

Additional P.E. Projects which will continue for 2017/2018

- Working with staff to ensure that children participate in at least 3 inter school competitions or tournaments throughout the year, linked to the PE curriculum.
- Involving the Sport Ambassadors in finding out what children at Monks Copenhall Academy would like to be offered for after school sporting activities.
- Development of Play leader scheme to involve year 5 children in a training programme during PE lessons.
- To continue to work on specific targets in order to gain the School Games Kite mark award for the third year running. Silver Award was achieved this year.
